## What is S\*M\*A\*R\*T

Founded in 1982 the club has 54 chapters across the U.S. that encompasses all 50 states. **Emphasis on Serving Veterans** - As a social club, we have chapters for golfers, computer users, and for travelers who just travel. Whether it is a luncheon, a weekend gathering or a week long campout (called a muster); activities include simple pleasures such as playing games, socializing, sharing potluck meals on musters, and monthly luncheons; to involvement in community activities, volunteering at Veterans Homes and Hospitals.
